#### **Enrolment Forms / Immunisation History Statements**

<u>All</u> children that will be attending Country Life Child Care in 2015 need to provide a completed Enrolment Form and an Up To Date Immunisation History Statement. These are legal requirements.

Unfortunately if an up to date Immunisation History Statement has not been provided, <u>your child cannot attend the Centre</u>. A statement can be obtained directly from a Medicare Office or you can access the MyGov website, link your Medicare Service to your account and request a copy of the statement to be emailed to us at <a href="mailto:admin@countrylifeccc.com.au">admin@countrylifeccc.com.au</a>.

Every time your child has a vaccination up to the age of 4, you will need to provide us with an updated statement.

Please do not hesitate to speak with Miss Karen in the office if you need assistance with this.

#### **Change of Details**

It is vital that we hold the most current contact information details for your child. If ever your details change, eg. phone number, address, emergency contacts and their numbers, you must advise us in writing immediately. You can email us or we have a form that you can fill out. Please see your child's Educator for a form if required.
